

2019 Mini-Quilt Silent Auction Guidelines

For every quilt show, we ask members to make and donate small quilts for our Mini-Quilt Silent Auction. We display quilts of various sizes each day of the show for bidding. The highest bidder at the end of each day at 3 pm is the winner of the quilt.

Our goal is to have at least 100 quilts – 50 for each day of the show. Quilts can be appliquéd, pieced, or paper-pieced. Total perimeter should not exceed 80 inches. They can be square, rectangular or round – your choice. There is no minimum perimeter measurement. The quilt should have a sleeve or some type of hanger on the back. Please label your quilt or pin your name on the back. Hopefully we will sell them all but if not, they will be returned to the maker. Since we no longer have a boutique for you to display your handmade items, this is your chance to make something special for the quilt show.
